- From the information you provided it appears Everglades College will be terminating their meet of understanding with AF5 around February 28, 2002. Therefore, please explain in detail who will provide the flight training services formerly provided by AFS. Also, please provide any contracts or agreements Everglades College has with the new provider for the flight training services.

Please explain the substantial increase in revenues and expenditures when
