MATERNAL HEALTH FOR VETERANS ACT



VETERANS

Servicewomen and veterans face increased risk of poor maternal health outcomes— Black veterans experience severe complications much more often than white veterans.



BUILDING ON SUCCESS

Protecting Moms Who Served was signed into law by President Biden on 11/30/2021, and was the first piece of legislation from the Omnibus to become law.

This bill would reauthorize funding from Protecting Moms Who Served—which was part of the Black Maternal Health Omnibus of 2021 and was enacted that year after receiving bipartisan support. The funding supports the Department of Veterans' Affairs (VA) maternity health care and coordination programs and requires reporting from the VA on maternal health services and outcomes.
